



**Bellefontaine City Schools Pre-Kindergarten  
Screening and Registration  
To Be Held at First Lutheran Church**

The Bellefontaine City School District has announced the district's Pre-Kindergarten Screening Program will be held at the First Lutheran Church, located at 208 West Sandusky Avenue, from April 9 through April 12, 2018.

Children who will be five years old on or before August 1, 2018 are eligible to attend kindergarten during the 2018-2019 school year. Parents are encouraged to register an eligible child by calling Bellefontaine Elementary at 599-4331 **before March 23, 2018**. Registration notices are being sent home with elementary school children and with children attending local pre-school programs. Additional notices are available at each school.

Parents are asked to bring the following to kindergarten screening:

Screening of each child's communication skills, hearing, vision, and academics provides information for planning the best educational experience for your child.
